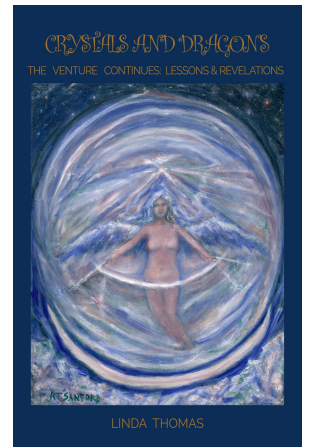

Celebrating Beltane

Beginning of May

Beltane is a Celtic celebration which marks the beginning of Summer. Unlike agricultural societies, the Celts were a pastoral people and only observed two seasons - summer and winter.

Traditionally celebrated on May 1, Beltane marks the midway between the spring equinox and summer solstice, which means the astronomical date for Beltane this year in the northern hemisphere passes early Saturday, May 6th, near the time of the full moon.

Beltane is a time to perform rituals promoting fertility and fecundity. Large bonfires were lit at a sacred site to symbolically purify, revitalize and bless nearby homesteads and herds. Flowers such as primrose, roan, hawthorn, horse, hazel and marigold adorned doorways and windows as bouquets, garlands or crosses.

Today, Beltane is a reminder that self-acceptance is vital to developing healthy, flourishing relationships.

May Flowers Divination

From Llewellyn's Beltane Sabbat Essentials

Here's a traditional Beltane divination custom that's extremely simple. Go out into a field of daisies or dandelions, close your eyes and pick a large handful while thinking of an important long-term goal. Open your eyes and count the total number of flower blossoms in your bouquet. The number indicates how many years will pass before your wish comes true. As an alternative you may ask a yes or no question, determined by counting the number of blossoms. An even number indicates no while an odd number of flowers indicates yes.

Finding Your Guides

Between Wicca classes and readings at Barjon's, I am often asked how to actively contact our spirit guides. While it's a relatively straight-forward process, it does require practice and patience.

To start, cleanse your space with smoke or your preferred method to keep negativity out. Frankincense, myrrh, sage, and cedar are all effective. Then, sit quietly in meditation with the intention of contacting a guide. I start by focusing on regular breathing and relaxing.

When ready, picture yourself in a forest with a stream before you. Step over the stream to represent the transition to the unconscious mind and go along the trail before you. Soon you will come to a clearing in the woods. Go to the middle and ask your guide to reveal themselves.

This is where patience is often needed. When someone shows up, be it an ancestor, guide or Deity, thank them for coming and have a mind to mind conversation. When it's over, thank them again and leave something as a token of appreciation. Then see yourself walking back to the stream, crossing it, and coming back to your body.

If no one appears to you after a few minutes, don't be discouraged. Try again. If the spirit that comes wasn't what you expected, don't worry. Spirit gives us what we need most at the time before we get what we want. If done consistently over several weeks, it gets easier and a lot of guides can be met and a lot of growth can occur.

Gaia, Mother of all Life

In Greek mythology, Gaia was the first deity from whom all others sprang. She was born of Chaos, but as Chaos receded, Gaia came into being. Lonely, she created a spouse named Uranus, but he became lusty and cruel, so Gaia persuaded her other children to help her subdue their father.

Cronos, her son, took a flint sickle to defeat Uranus. Gaia went on to have other mates including Tartarus and Pontus with whom she bore many children.



Gaia is the primal mother goddess, complete in herself. The Greeks believed that an oath sworn by Gaia was the strongest since no one could escape from the Earth herself. Besides being the creator of the other primordial deities, the mighty Titans, and many other entities, Gaia is also believed to be the origin of prophecy in Greek mythology.

The gift of foresight was unique to women and goddesses until Apollo became the god of prophecy: even then, it was a role shared with his cousin, Hecate.
